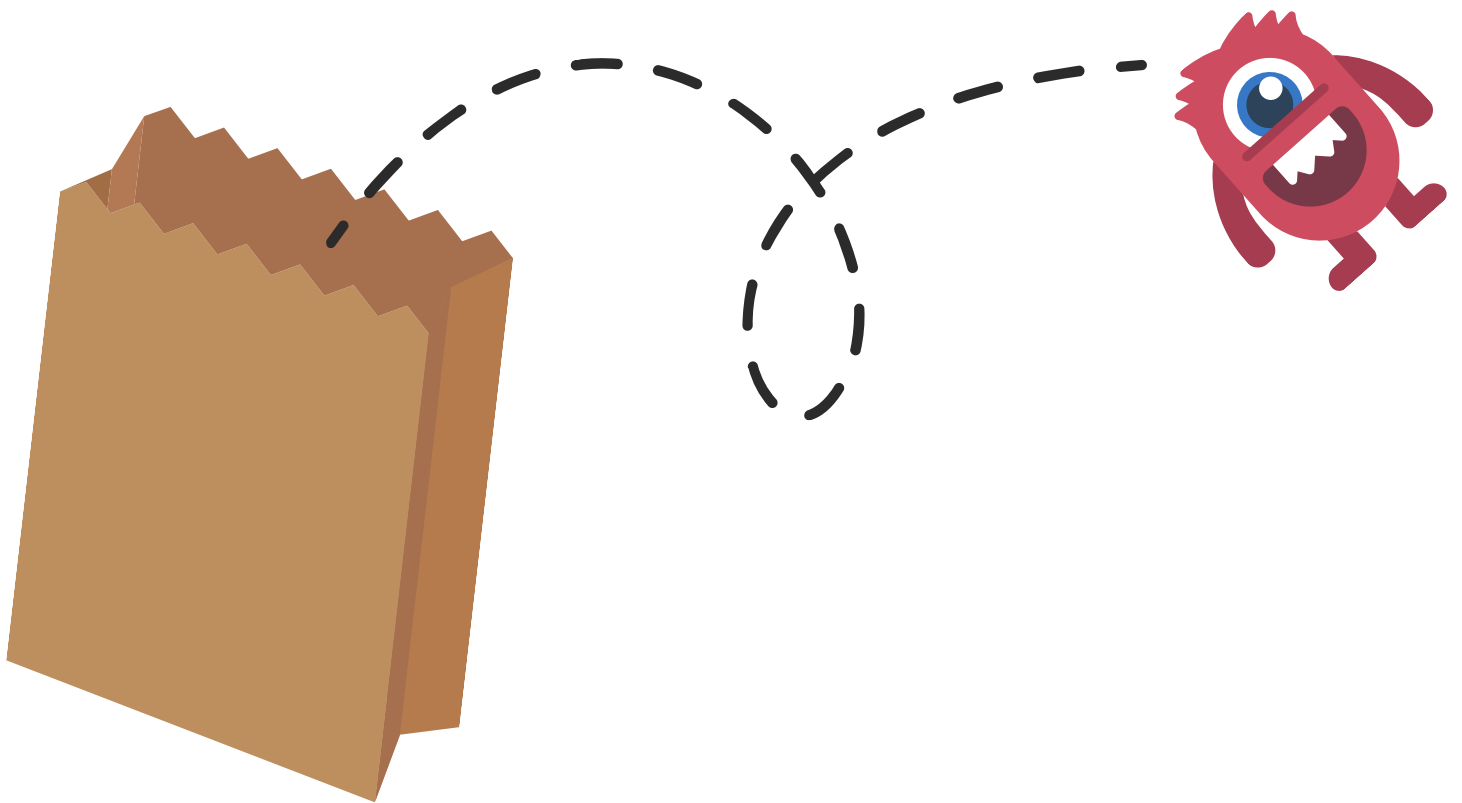


# COUNTING TOSS GAME



# HOW TO USE THIS ACTIVITY

## Materials to gather:

- Paper lunch bags
- Scissors
- Marker
- Clothespins
- Masking tape for a line on the ground if needed.

## How to play the game:

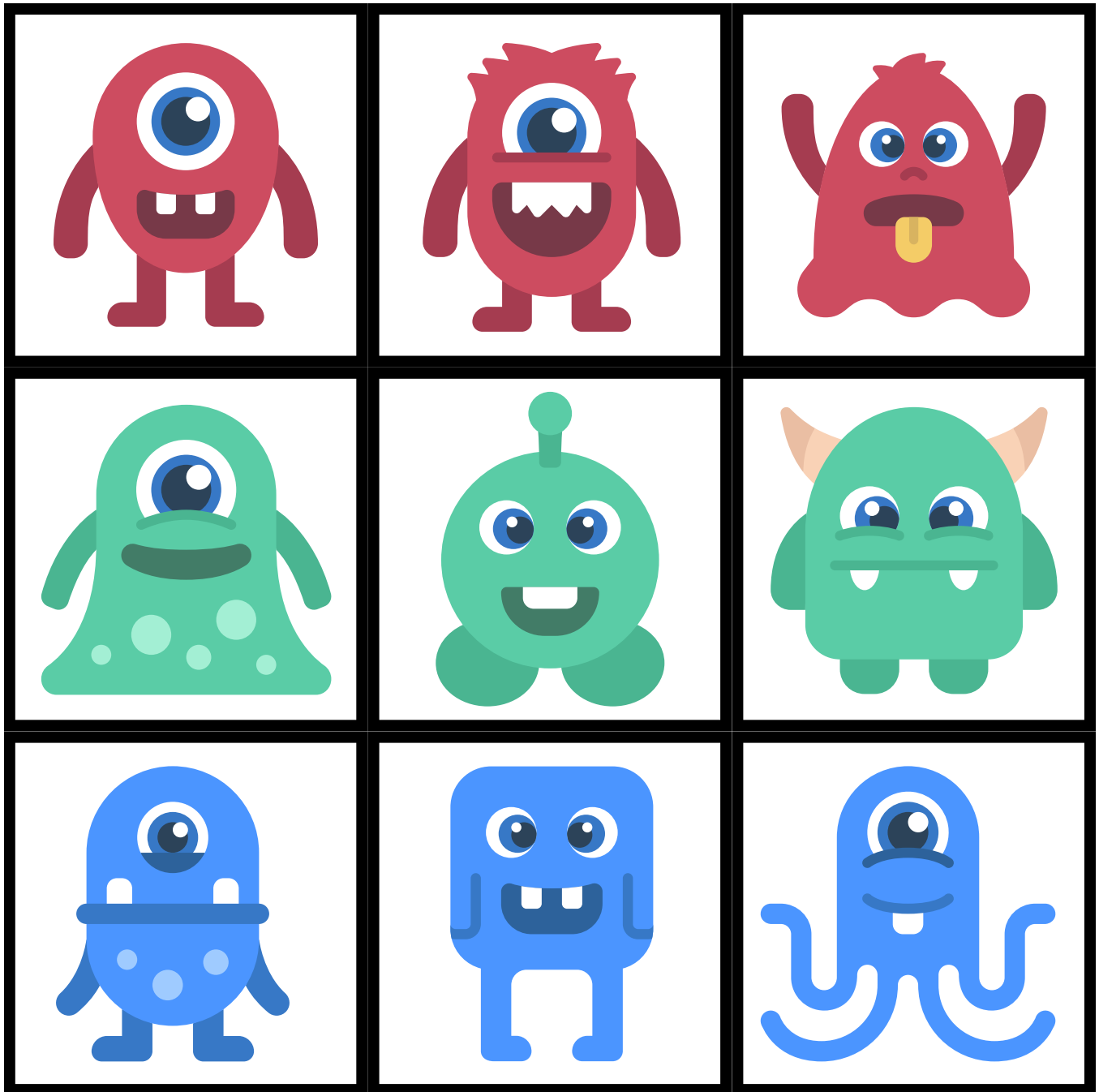
- Print off the collection of characters that you want to play with, onto heavy cardstock is best. You may need several copies.
- Cut out the squares.
- Clip each one with a clothespin so that it can be tossed.
- Prepare 2 or more bags by writing a large number on the front.
- Open up the lunch bag and fold down the top one or 2 times so that it stands up with the top open wide.
- Put down a tape line where the player will stand.
- Then place the bags a reasonable distance from the line (base it on your child's ability...you want them to succeed at this)
- Have your kiddo toss the character pieces into the bags based on the number written on the front. (eg-if there is a 3 on the front of the bag, they will toss in 3 characters.)
- You can play this with several people, taking turns to fill bags with the same number on them. See who can fill their bag first.

## Alternate play:

- Write a simple math problem on the front of the bag and answer it by throwing the correct amount of items in the bag.
