
# SHAPE & COLOR TOSS GAME



### **HOW TO USE THIS ACTIVITY**


#### Materials to gather:

- Paper lunch bags
- Scissors
- Marker
- Clothespins
- Masking tape for a line on the ground if needed.


#### How to play the game:

- Print off the color or shape collection that you want to play with, onto heavy cardstock is best.
- Cut out the squares.
- Clip each one with a clothespin so that it can be tossed.
- Prepare a bag for each color or shape for the card you have chosen. For example, if you picked a collection with 2 shapes, draw the shape on each of 2 bags.
- Open up the lunch bag and fold down the top one or 2 times.
- Put down a tape line where the player will stand.
- Then place the bags a reasonable distance from the line (base it on your child's ability...you want them to succeed at this)
- Have your kiddo toss the shapes or colors pieces into the correct bag for points.
- You can play this with more than one play and take turns to toss and see who gets more points.
- Print as many sheets as you want for the game


Prepare lunch bags with the colors red, green and blue on the front.




Prepare lunch bags with the shapes of a diamond and heart on the front.




Prepare lunch bags with the colors orange and purple on the front.



Prepare lunch bags with the shapes of a square, circle and triangle on the front.



Prepare lunch bags with the colors of yellow and pink on the front.
